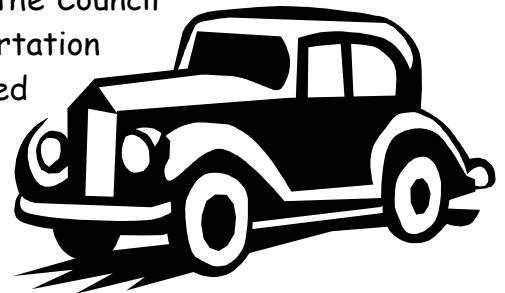
Street Signs ... In the first edition of FOCUS, Allan pointed

out the number of damaged or worn street signs in our area. Specifically, he mentioned the badly worn street sign at Margaret Crescent, pictured right. We're pleased to say that after the FOCUS Team contacted the Council about this, we received a promise that this sign would be replaced.

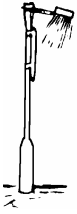


Poor pavements ... You'll recall that Allan raised the issue of the poor pavement at the south end of Noran Avenue. Many residents have since been in touch with Allan about the really poor condition of footways in Broughty Ferry Road and Dalgleish Road and FOCUS has contacted the Planning & Transportation Department about this.

CRAIGIE AVENUE ... Residents have raised with Allan their concerns about the speed of some vehicles along Craigie Avenue. FOCUS contacted the Council about this. We are pleased to report that Planning & Transportation Department has agreed to undertake a check of traffic speed surveys in the area and if no survey in Craigie Avenue has been carried out recently, a speed survey here will be undertaken. Allan will keep residents advised of the feedback in future editions of FOCUS.

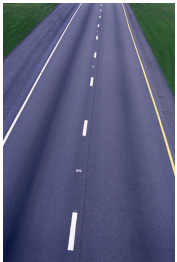
