KINGSWAY EXIT IMPROVEMENT

Residents who have received FOCUS in the past will recall that the LibDem FOCUS Team had raised the residents' concerns about the speed of vehicles coming off Kingsway heading south down Strathmartine Road. The FOCUS Team raised this with the City Council, who agreed to our request for a "SLOW" marking on the roadway to encourage vehicles to slow down here. As the photo (right) shows, this work has now been done.



WORN WHITE LINES CONCERN

Murray Dick has responded to concerns raised about the very worn white junction lines at the Bruce Street junction with Kinghorne Road by writing to Dundee City Council's Planning & Transportation Department, asking for them to be repainted. As the photo (left) shows these are really worn badly.
