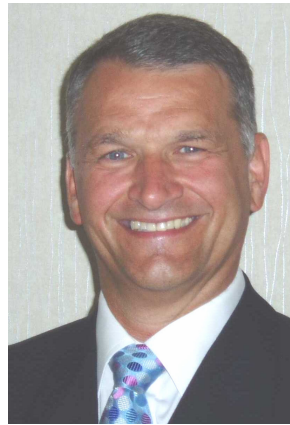

KINGSWAY RETAIL PARK : Many residents have complained to the FOCUS Team about the inadequate bus shelter at the retail park, and following FOCUS contacting the Planning & Transportation Department about this, a site meeting has been arranged with the retail park's owners Land Securities, City Council officials and Cllr Helen Dick attending. We hope that, arising from this, a better bus shelter providing real shelter from the elements will be provided.



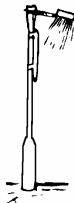
Downie Park Road : In the last edition of FOCUS, Murray mentioned that FOCUS had contacted Dundee City Council about the faded street sign in Downie Park Road (see left). We are pleased to report that the City Council has since advised us that the sign would be replaced with a new one.

Poor pavement condition update : You will recall from FOCUS edition 25 that Murray raised residents' concerns about poor pavement condition at several locations in our area. A number of residents have raised concerns about the condition of parts of the pavement of Park Road and FOCUS has raised this with Dundee City Council.

Crossing Success! Residents who have received FOCUS for some time will be aware that the local LibDem FOCUS Team has been campaigning for better crossing facilities on Clepington Road east of the Kingsway West Retail Park. We are pleased to advise that Dundee City Council has now advised us that a pedestrian refuge on Clepington Road near the junction with Johnston Avenue has now been agreed and it is expected that the improvement will be in place before the end of the current financial year which ends in March 2007.
