

# Investment in your gas supply



## Perth Road / Nethergate, Dundee

Starting on 21 April 2008 Scotland Gas Networks (SGN) the gas pipeline operator, will be investing £400,000 replacing 1.4km of gas mains in Perth Road and Nethergate Dundee (From Patons Lane to 158 Nethergate).

This essential work will be split into two phases taking 23 weeks in total to complete.

As part of the planning process SGN has been meeting with Dundee City Council and will continue to do so to take into account their views and any special requirements to ensure the effective programming of the project. We shall continue to work with the local authority, bus companies and local community throughout the course of the project.

Temporary traffic restrictions, including road closures, local diversions and parking restrictions will be in operation for phased periods throughout the project. Information signs will be posted at strategic locations to warn road users of the gas mains replacement work. Turriff Contractors will be carrying out the work for SGN and during the road closure they will also be carrying out some manhole cover/frame repair works for Scottish Water in the same locations.

**All shops and businesses will be open for business as usual. Parking will be suspended in Perth Road adjacent to the works. Access for pedestrians and delivery vehicles will be maintained, although this may be restricted at times.**

### Construction Details:

#### Phase 1: Monday 21 April 08 – 11 August 08 (16 weeks)

We will begin construction from the west side of Patons Lane junction to Roseangle and a full road closure will be in place from Patons Lane to Roseangle. Traffic will be diverted via Hawkhill. Throughout the closure there may be a requirement to suspend the parking on Roseangle.

#### Phase 2: Monday 28 July 08 – 29 September 08 (9 weeks)

Phase 2 overlaps phase 1 by two weeks to accommodate an early finish of the work in phase 1, but phase 2 will not go ahead until phase 1 is completed.

There will be a westbound closure on Nethergate from Roseangle to South TAY Street. Westbound traffic will be diverted via Hawkhill, however, the road will remain open for city bound traffic. Again there may be a requirement to suspend the parking on Roseangle during this phase.
